RESEARCH COMMERCIALIZATION - U.S. SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH MATCHING GRANTS

HTDC provides up to 50% State matching funds for Hawaii companies who have received federal SBIR awards to grow their ideas from concept to commercial products.

MANUFACTURING ASSISTANCE - INNOVATE HAWAII (MEP)

Innovate Hawaii is federally funded by the National Institutes of Standards and Technology and provides technical business assistance to small- and medium-size manufacturers.

HAWAII CENTER FOR ADVANCED TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGIES (HCATT)

HCATT develops and demonstrates technologies for renewable energy transportation systems.

TECH BUSINESS INCUBATION PROGRAM (MANOA AND KIHEI)

Two incubation facilities that offer shared resources, business services, consultants, mentors and shared and flexible-lease offices in a community of tech entrepreneurs.

STARTUP MENTORING

HTDC hosts training workshops, networking events and conferences for the tech community.
