1. Call to Order

2. Roll Call

Mr. Higashi introduces Mr. Murakami who is the designee for the new DBEDT Director, James Tokioka who was unable to attend today.

3. Approval of the April 11, 2023 Minutes

4. Manufacturing Assistance Program (MAP)

Mr. Layugan briefs the board on the Manufacturing Assistance Program which provides grants to manufacturers in the state for manufacturing activities that result in economic and employment growth. The amount funded allocated to the MAP is dependent every year on the legislative appropriation. Each year there are more qualified applicants than there are funds available. This year there were 85 applications, only 68 were eligible for review (17 applications were either incomplete or did not meet eligibility requirements). 26 applicants will be awarded and of those seven are first time applicants.

Mr. Kimura questions the scoring method and fairness towards the smaller businesses.

Mr. Higashi and Mr. Layugan reiterates that this has been addressed by the federal government and that awards are based on economic and employment growth.

5. Strategic Plan Update

Mr. Higashi briefs the board on the status of the HTDC strategic plan. Notating between June to August there will be research and data gathering, site visits and community input meetings, stakeholder interview and expected outcomes. Goal is to have 10 x \$1 billion companies in 10 years.

6. Executive Director's Report

Mr. Higashi reviews the Executive Director's report. Advising that the legislative session is closing but we are still waiting for the final reports. There are three bills that impact HTDC, adding four positions and \$65 million. Another change located in Bill HB999 will be replacing the University of Hawaii representative, Vassilis Syrmos with a University of Hawaii Board Regent member. Accelerator awards have been awarded for early-stage companies and this is part of our strategic plan. The Entrepreneurs Sandbox RFP was finalized and has been awarded to Impact Hub. MEP awarded an additional \$400,000 toward their program.

The current job description will be circulated to the Board and any comments on input to be sent to Ms. Fujiyama directly, do not include any other member on the email, by Wednesday, May 17, 2023.
